Adult-Adolescent Parenting Inventory (AAPI-2)

The AAPI-2 has proven invaluable in assessing the parenting attitudes and child-rearing beliefs of parents and adolescents. Founded on five parenting constructs known to lead to abusive parenting, the AAPI provides scores that profile parents at risk for abusing and neglecting children.

Description:

In this 3 day training, Participants will learn:

- ♦ The **philosophy, values, goals, structure, and validation of the Nurturing Parenting Program®.**
- ♦ How the **5 Constructs are taught and understood in the Program, through activities** relating to child development, personal power, alternatives to corporal punishment, and building self-esteem, self-concept and empathy in parents and children.
- ♦ A hands-on approach to **Implementing and Conducting group and home based Nurturing Parenting Programs®** that includes practice sessions, use of program materials, videos and assessment tools, children's and parents' program activities, family home practice assignments, icebreakers.
- ♦ Application of the Adult-Adolescent Parenting Inventory (AAPI-2)
